

- POSITION:** Parish Associate for Worship, Faith Formation and Pastoral Care
- PURPOSE:** To serve Lowcountry Presbyterian Church on an interim basis working primarily with Worship, Faith Formation and Congregational Care Ministries.
- ACCOUNTABILITY:** To the Session of Lowcountry Presbyterian Church, through its Personnel Committee, under the supervision and leadership of the Pastor. The Parish Associate is also accountable to the COM of CAP
- COMPENSATION:** Exempt – Part-time position; salary commensurate with experience. Benefits negotiable. Open to ordained and non-ordained, qualified candidates.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**1. Worship**

- Preach approximately 1 Sunday per month at both services (additional preaching may be required when the Pastor is on vacation or study leave).
- Participate in three of the four Sunday services (both services).

**2. Faith Formation**

- Provide Leadership for Faith Formation Ministry Team.
- Teach Bible study series as scheduled with the Faith Formation Ministry Team.
- Lead Adult Sunday School at least 1 Sunday per month.
- Lead small group book studies as needed.

**3. Pastoral Care**

- Provide pastoral services in cooperation with the Pastor and Congregational Care Ministry.

**4. Other Optional Opportunities**

- Assist the Outreach Ministry Team in their efforts to help build bridges between church and community by helping to develop ministries which address community needs, showing the love of Christ to all outside the church.
- Assist the Outreach Ministry Team in its advocacy and justice work in support of our community.
- Assist the Communications Ministry with maintaining the church's website.
- Perform any additional duties as assigned by the Pastor.

Presence in church office approximately 2 to 3 weekdays per week as agreed upon with the Pastor. The expectation is that many of the tasks outlined above would be conducted during office hours.

It is anticipated the position is approximately 20 to 25 hours per week. Responsibilities, hours, and compensation are negotiable.
